FLOOD RESILIENCE

Flood is a necessary evil

- Unless severe, it helps rejuvenates the fields
- Villagers are normally displaced for a week or two
- Raised Handpumps and Toilets will alleviate health issues during flood
- AFNA sponsored 3 raised handpumps in 2020
- AFNA helped with boats for mobility during flood season in the past
- Also co-developed the Child Friendly Space (CFS) concept with RVC for flood relief camps



RELIEF EXECUTED in the USA

- **USA Wildfires - \$10,000**
 - Support provided to Fire Fighter Families in the states of Washington, Oregon and California
- **Feeding America – \$5,000 Thanksgiving 2020**
 - 20,000 meals provided

AKSHAR FOUNDATION



- **Vocational Training for Children who could not continue school**
 - **Training on Landscaping Design:**
 - Creation of mini golf course, planting of ornamental hedges, grafting fruits for the nursery & cultivation of organic vegetables
 - Completed ~75% of the project so far
 - Funded – ₹ 1,61,000 (materials, equipment, transportation & salaries)
 - **Training on Recycling:**
 - Completed building of a recycling machine (Precious Plastics) to recycle plastics bags and plastic bottles
 - Students are constructing eco-bricks on their own
 - Funded – ₹ 2,61,800 (partial funding for equipment and transportation)



AKSHAR FOUNDATION

- Message from 4 students who had to drop out from school and were working as child laborers; now productive members of the society

➤ Home for Girls aged 18 and under:

- Total permanent residents have increased from 36 to 40 by end of 2020
- Vocational trainer for weaving, doll making, arts and crafts has been hired on a part time basis
- All children at the home have been partially or fully vaccinated on a special government initiative
- Home renovations for improved living conditions underway
- Installation of a water purifier and purchasing of essential medical equipment have been prioritized
- 2021 contribution - ₹403,200

- **SENEH (Bhabada Devi Memorial Trust):**
 - 5th year of supporting SENEH
 - 30 women all over 55 years old
 - Mental and physical care is of utmost need
 - \$6000 (or Rs. 4,10,000) a year for healthcare expenses

WEAVING FOR LIVING

- **Weaving Center setup**
 - Located in Mission Birubala office campus in Goalpara, West Assam
 - Engages multiple weavers from the Mission and also women rescued from Witch-Hunting
 - AFNA provided seed funding to procure looms & yarn
 - On a self-sustaining mode after initial investment recovering running cost from sale of traditional clothes
 - AFNA's grant-Rs. 1,76,687.00 (~\$2400)


FEMALE HYGIENE KIT

➤ Phase I (2021-2022):

- Create awareness – translate “MOON TIME” to Assamese – July 2021
- Print and distribute locally, in collaboration with Spherule Foundation and Mission Pink Health (IMA) – target is to distribute 10,000 for free by mid 2022
- Supply free Hygiene Kits – second half 2021 - 2022

➤ Phase II (Late 2022):

- Biodegradable pads – donate compostable pads for underprivileged girls in remote villages
- Reusable pads – donate reusable pads in collaboration with Parijat Academy
