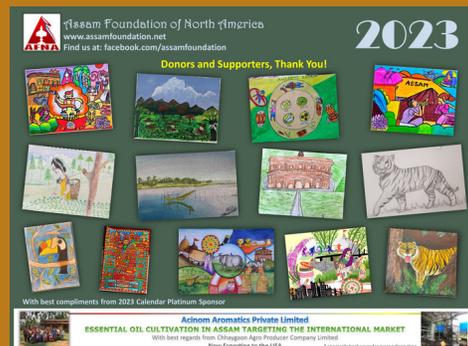
WEAVING FOR CARE - STILL ACCEPTING CONTRIBUTIONS!!
